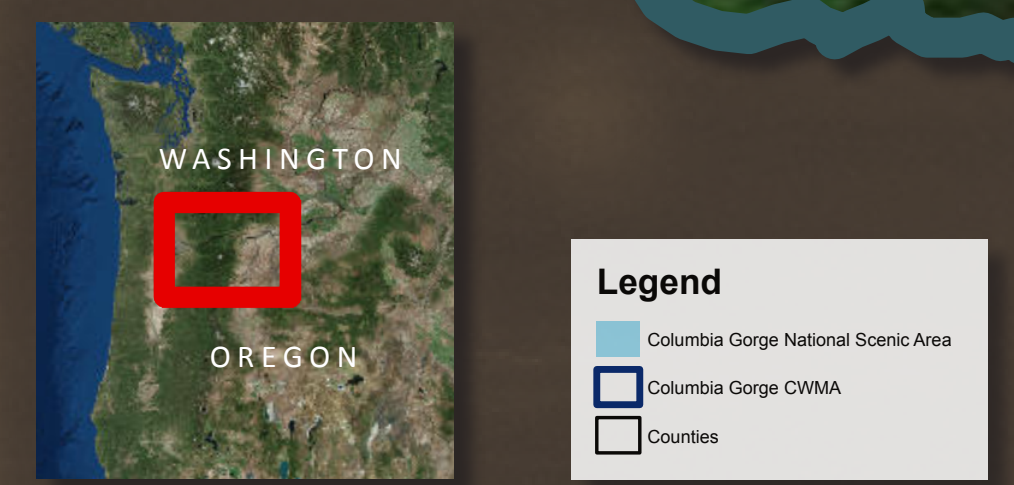
Education
